It is expected that the team will share the overall responsibilities of the District Lead Volunteer role by taking the lead for one of following four pillars:

- Support to Groups
- Programme Support and Events
- Volunteer recruitment and Development
- District Support

Or by taking on the overall team leader role who will coordinate the Lead Volunteer team.

Team members for each pillar will be responsible for recruiting and supporting a team of volunteers to deliver on agreed development actions to support the groups and young people across the District.

Being part of Team DC will be rewarding and give you an opportunity to develop yourself as well as inspire the Adult Volunteers and young people across the District it will also look great on your CV, demonstrating to prospective employers that you have some amazing additional skills.
